## **1st Circular**

The first joint meeting of the **Working Group Central European Heteropterologists** and the **Arbeitskreis Zikaden Mitteleuropas** will be held from **2 til 4 September 2022 in Freiberg** (Saxony, Germany). It is organised by Dr. Roland Achtziger (Institute of Biosciences, Biology and Ecology Unit at TU Bergakademie Freiberg).

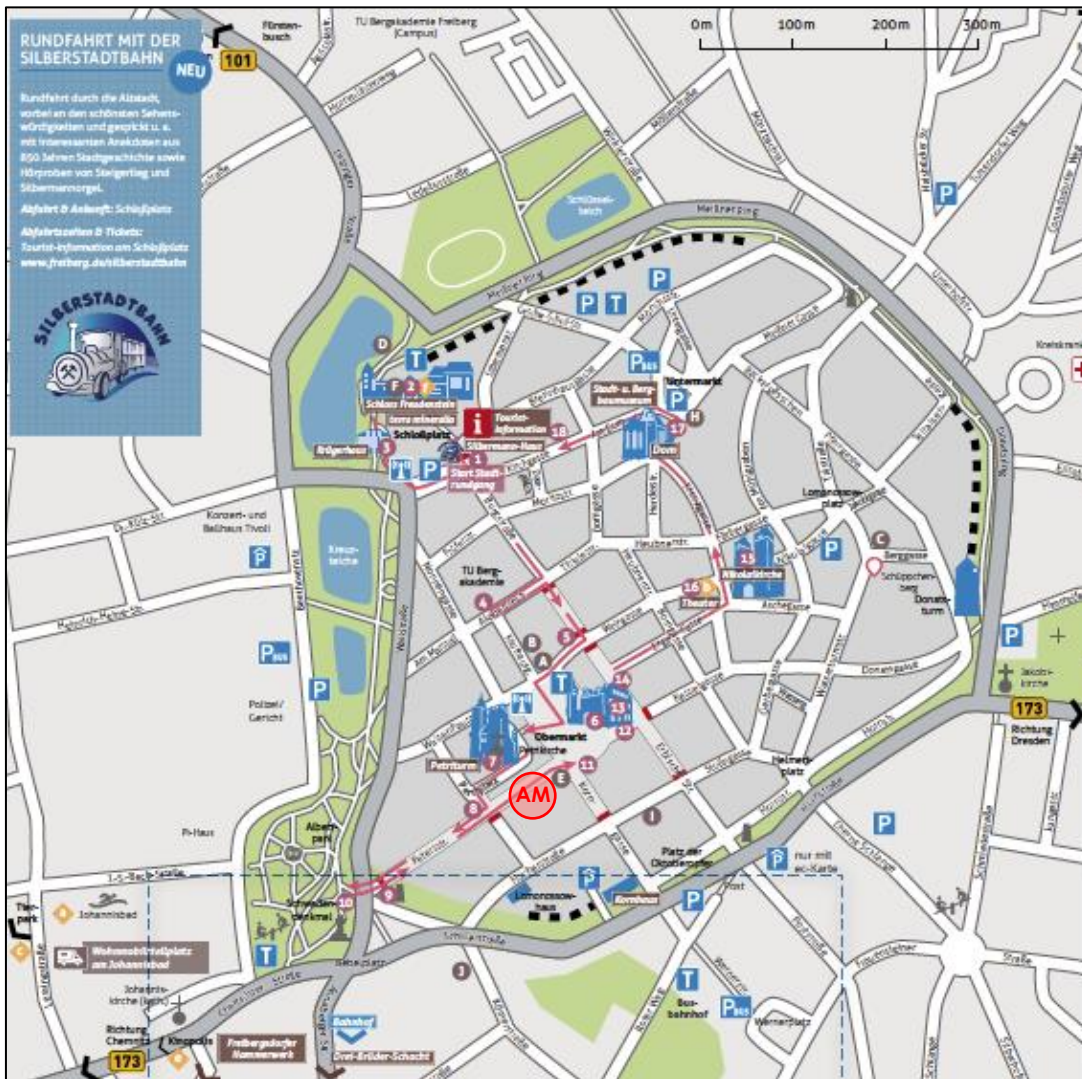

### **(1) Venue Freiberg**

- Traditional **mining and university town** with a nice historic center
- **Technische Universität Bergakademie Freiberg:**
  - founded in 1765 and thus the oldest mining university world wide
  - famous students Studenten: Alexander von Humboldt and Georg Philipp Friedrich von Hardenberg (Novalis)
  - famous scientists: Abraham Gottlob Werner (founder of mineralogy), Clemens Winkler (discoverer of the chemical element Germanium), Ferdinand Reich and Theodor Richter (discoverer of the element Indium)
  - terra mineralia: One of the largest and most impressive mineral exhibitions of the world (Schloss Freudenstein)
- **Dome St. Marien** with 2 historian organs of the famous organ builder Gottfried Silbermann, 2 spectacular pulpits, a romanic gate called „Golden portal“ and a unique sepulture of the Albertiner
- Oldest, continuously working **city theater** of the world (“Little Semper opera”)
- **Teaching and research mine** „Reiche Zeche“ (visits are currently not possible due to reconstruction)
- **UNESCO heritage** „**Montanregion Erzgebirge/Krušnohoř**“: Many historical buildings etc. from nearly 1000 years of mining history in the city area

### **(2) Meeting venue for talks and meeting office: Alte Mensa**

Talks and poster presentations will be held in the building „Alte Mensa“, Petersstraße 5 in Freiberg (<https://tu-freiberg.de/universitaet/profil/campusplan/alte-mensa-petersstrasse-5>) (location see Fig. 1).

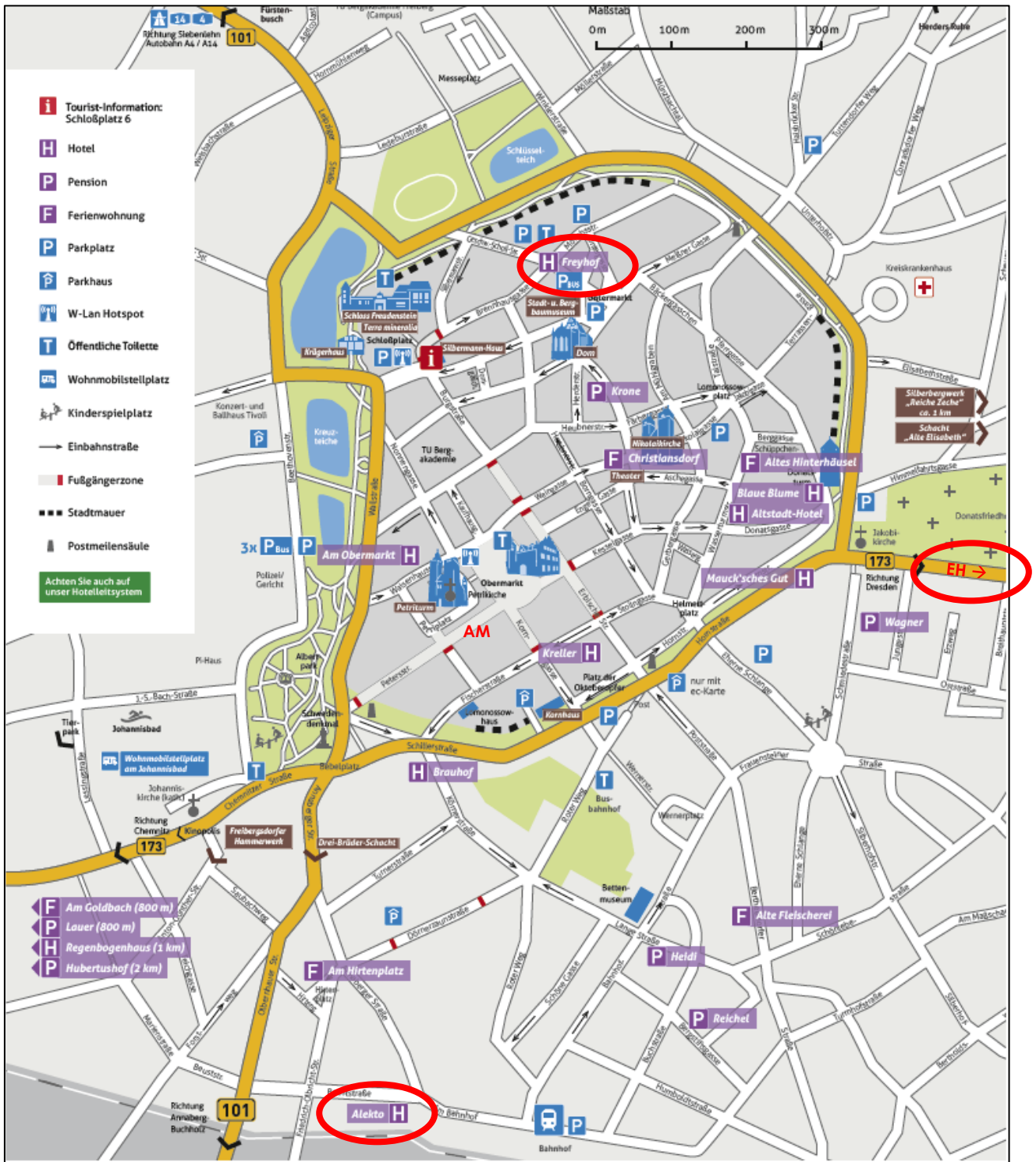
